Alder & Maple - Log Lengths: 16' - 40'

Cottonwood - Log Lengths: 16' - 40'

- 1) Apply 4" of trim per 8' or 10' multiple
- 2) Minimum top diameter is 6" on Alder and Maple; 8" on Cottonwood
- 3) Max butt diameter on Cottonwood is 32"
- 4) Chip N Saw Alder 5" Minimum Diameter (Absolute)
- 5) Alder pulp must be clean, suitable for conveyor travel with a minimum diameter of 3 inches. 10% maple allowable per load. No cottonwood.

General Rules:

- 1) Log purchase agreement required 24 hours prior to shipping.
- 2) No double ended loads. All log ends must be bucked square and clean.
- 3) All logs shall be produced from live trees and shall have limbs trimmed flush with log.
- 4) All logs must be suitable for conveyor travel and mechanical debarking.
- 5) Sawlog preferred lengths are 18', 20', 28', 30', 38' and 40'.
- 6) Only saw head type feller buncher logs will be accepted. No spike tip conveyor processors. Excessive processor damage will result in scaling deductions.
- 7) **Load ticket required for all loads.**
Information to include: log seller, split instruction and hold out (if any). Please include name, address and phone number for landowner and logger on load ticket.

**Log defect should be removed in the woods:
Broken ends, pistol butts, shake or shatter
breaks, crotches, rot, etc.**
